**MEDICATION POLICY**

As part of our goal, Merrimack Adult Day Health Center will promote the participant's independence as much as possible. We recognize safety needs as a primary concern to us at all times. Along these lines, we ask each participant to bring only medication into the center that is ordered by a physician with instructions in a pharmacy labeled container. These medications need be brought to the Nursing Department.

State regulations require medication to be stored in a locked space that the Nursing Department has access to.

Participants who have had diarrhea, a temperature over 100 or have vomited over the past 24 hours will not be allowed to attend the program for safety and health of the participant and all other participants attending the program. Any questions may be brought to the nurse's attention for clarification.

Participants/families should notify the Nurse of any change in physician, diagnosis, and or medication changes.
